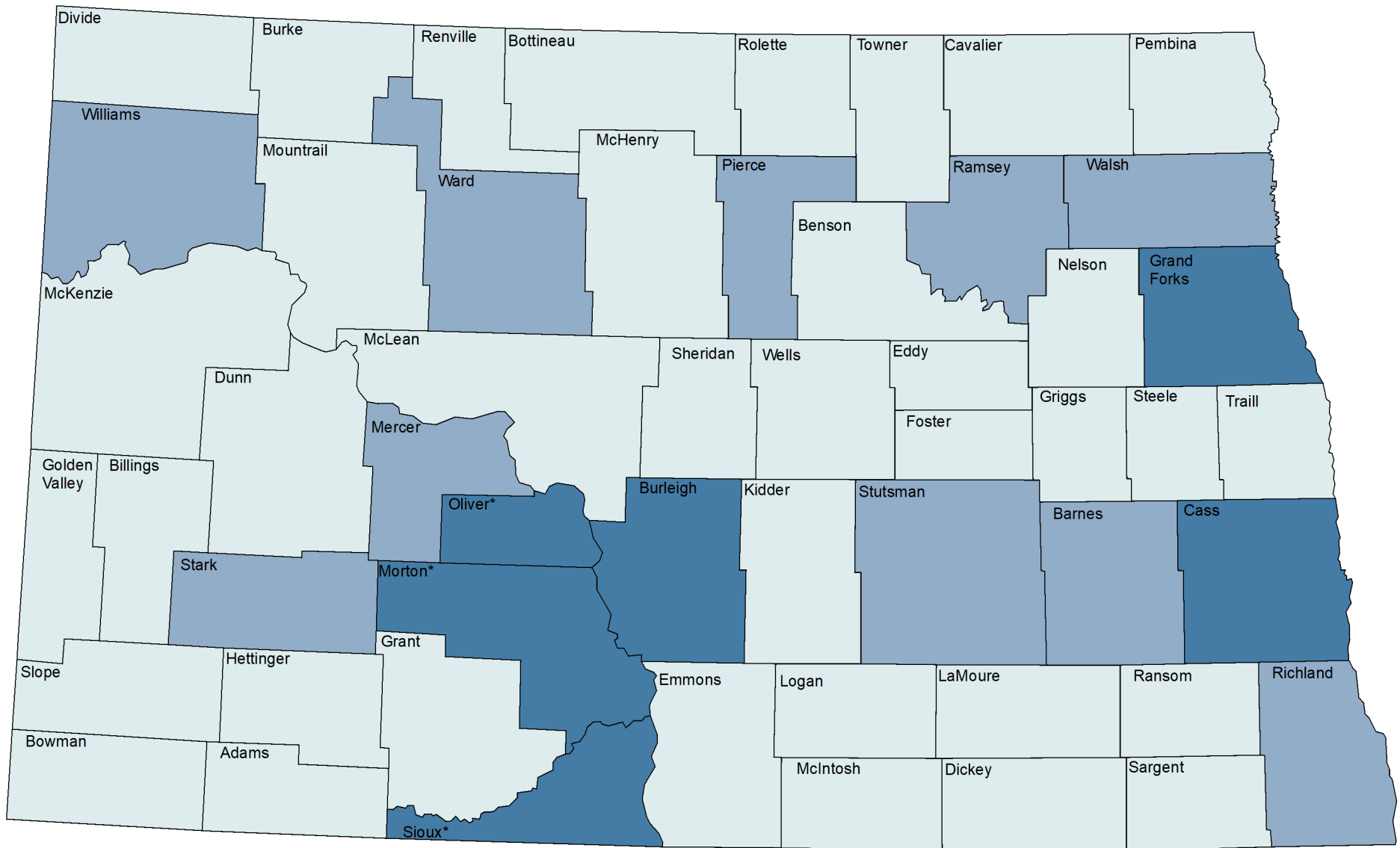


# North Dakota County Classification



\*Adjacent counties having a high degree of social and economic integration with urban counties as measured through commuting ties

- Urban** (Metro county with 50,000 population or more)
- Semi-Rural** (Non-Metro county that contains a town or city with 2,500 - 49,999 population)
- Rural** (Non-Metro, rural county that does not contain a town with at least 2,500 - 49,999 population)
