2023 Advocacy Priorities

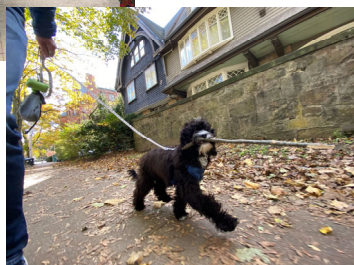
- Increase and protect funding for vital public health agencies and programs and strengthen the nation's public health infrastructure

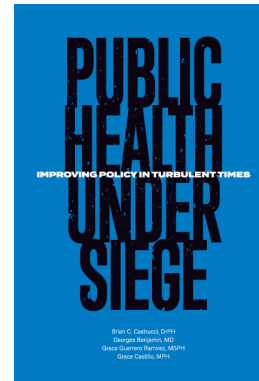



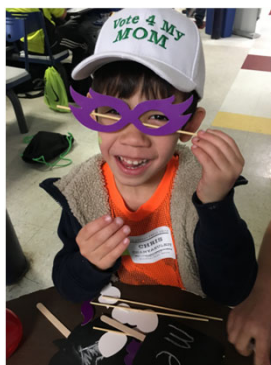
